Mike Card, a 1981 graduate of the University of Oregon with a BS in Finance and Economics, is the President and co-owner of Combined Transport, Inc, a family owned and operated trucking service founded in 1980 by his father, Richard Card. The company specialized in heavy hauling, glass hauling, heavy equipment hauling, and flatbed hauling. Listed as number 108 in Oregon Business magazine’s Top 150 Private Companies list, the Combined Transport reported revenue between \$75 million and \$100 million with ninety-seven employees in 2005.



He is also a principal of two Combined Transport affiliate companies, Cardmoore Trucking LP, a truck maintenance operation, and Cardmoore Properties, a property management service.

Mike was the guest of the LCE for the center’s highly successful “Entrepreneur on Campus” program on Tuesday, January 15, 2008. Both MBA and undergraduate entrepreneurial students took advantage of the opportunity to interface with Mike and tap into his years of experience at growing a thriving entrepreneurial business.
